

 Please dress up as either a film star, celebrity or superhero!



Match Formats

4 x 15 minute quarters

2 minute quarter breaks

5 minute half time

6 minute warm up allocation

Teams must be ready to start on time – time restrictions in place.

Lights are programmed to turn off at 10:00pm.

- No stoppages for goals, PCs or minor injuries.
- Draw in any semi-final, crossover or playoff game will result in shootout.

Team Personnel

Only those on the team registration form in the dugout please

Teams can use either:

seventeen (17) players including only one (1) goalkeeper. eighteen (18) players including two (2) fully kitted goalkeepers.

Teams cannot use more than 16 field players in a match.







Eligibility – defined in Tournament Rules

- Guests, transfers, etc if you require a dispensation discuss with TD
- Signed by all players

Match management

Altius will be run live

- Starting lineups not required
- HNZ will post team colours
- Be proactive to avoid colour clashes
- Always carry alternative playing strip
- Managers must check and 'sign' match sheet
- If protesting must sign 'under protest'

- suspect equipment subject to proper test


Remember COVID protocols

- Protests technical or procedural only not umpiring decisions
- NZ\$500 fee

Managers keep checking/using Altius


