

#### **SAFETY POLICIES**

The following policies can be found on www.hockeynz.co.nz.

#### HARASSMENT POLICY

In providing a safe and secure environment for participation in hockey, providers should ensure to the best of their ability players and officials are not subjected to any form of physical, psychological or sexual abuse as a result of their association with hockey.

#### **ANTI DOPING CODE**

Hockey NZ supports the New Zealand Government, Drug Free Sport NZ, the FIH and the IOC in the development of national and international initiatives to deter the misuse of drugs in sport. It recognises the need to take strong and positive action to reduce harm to the individual and to the sport, and to educate and inform those persons and organisations whom this policy applies.

#### **HEAD INJURY**

At all Hockey New Zealand tournaments, Hockey New Zealand insists that a player that has received a head injury with suspected concussion may only commence playing again when a medical certificate clearing the player of concussion has been supplied to the Tournament Director, or Tournament Administrator.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY**

This policy outlines the standards of discipline and behaviour expected of players, coaches, managers, officials, umpires and player spectators in accordance with the rules of Hockey NZ. The Code of Conduct Policy also outlines the process to hear any allegations of misconduct.

#### **MOUTH GUARD POLICY**

It is now mandatory for all players taking part in Hockey NZ Youth Tournaments to wear mouthguards. Hockey NZ strongly recommends the wearing of mouthguard by all players at all tournaments. Managers of all teams are to control the use of mouth guards, not the umpires.

#### **SMOKEFREE POLICY**

Hockey is a smokefree sport. We proudly endorse the Smokefree/Auahi Kore message as part of promoting healthy lifestyles to our members. This tournament is totally smoke free, inside and out. We appreciate you respecting our philosophy.







#### **General Information**

There are three locations for the tournament:

The National Hockey Stadium, 9 Mt Albert Road Kāpiti Sports Turf & Pavilion, 10 Scaife Drive Fraser Park Hockey Turf, 34 Percy Cameron Street

#### **Live Streaming:**

All matches on NHS 1 will be live-streamed. Days 1-6 will be one livestream all day. On the final day there will be seperate streams for individual matches. <u>View for free via Hockey New Zealand Youtube Channel.</u>

#### **Showers & Changing:**

There are changing, toilet and shower facilities at all sites. The changing rooms are not secure and personal gear should not be left in them. The teams will have access to the changing rooms at NHS and Fraser Park for 25 minutes, 45 minutes prior to the match (e.g. 9am game, access 8:15-8:40am) and for 25 minutes post match. Kāpiti have 4 changing rooms on-site and access to a large 20 shower facility, just a 2 minute walk south of the complex.

#### **Information Hub:**

There will be an Information Hub at The National Hockey Stadium (located underneath the Pavilion) which will be available for assistance, lost property, water, ice and any other event queries. This will be the main point of contact for the event, and we will then liaise with the Tournament Control room if necessary. Kāpiti have a lost property boc underneath the deck area and advise to hand any expensive items of value to the cafe.

#### **Physio & Massage:**

On the Practice Turf at The National Hockey Stadium there will be a physio and massage station for athletes and at Kāpiti there will be two onsite masseuses. All sites have local physio centres for athletes to book appointments with during the tournament.

#### Alcohol:

At all venues you are not permitted to bring your own alcohol. At NHS and Kāpiti, alcohol can be there are designated areas that you are allowed to consume alcohol purchased on site.

#### Ice:

For sale at NHS and Kāpiti for \$4. At NHS it is provided in the Information Hub, underneath the Pavilion. At Kāpiti it is for sale in the cafe, please pre-order large amounts in advance as Kāpiti has limited stock available. At Kāpiti please set up ice baths near the drain outside the men's changing room.

#### **Turf Rules**

- The Hockey facilities at all three sites are Smokefree Stadiums Smoking or vaping is not permitted inside the Hockey Stadium Grounds
- Please use the gateways provided to enter the turfs.
- Wear only approved footwear, ie. no metal sprigs, cleats or fittings. Goal keepers buckles must be covered to ensure no sharp edges protrude
- No food or alcohol, spitting or chewing gum is permitted on the turfs.
- Only officials and teams playing are allowed on the turf during the game.
- Coaches are permitted turf side, however, must remain near the dug-outs. All other team staff must remain in the team dug-out unless required on the turf by the umpires due to injury.
- After each game all rubbish, plastic drink bottles, strapping tape etc, must be removed from the turf and dug-outs and disposed of in the correct rubbish bins provided.
- No personal gear, equipment etc, is to be left inside the fence line of the turf while matches are in progress.
- Report any damage to the Tournament Administrator.






