There are four changing rooms downstairs with toilets and showers.

There will be a schedule up daily allocating teams to changing rooms.

The changing rooms are not secured, so personal gear is not to be left unattended.

All users are responsible for cleaning up their own rubbish on vacating the changing rooms.

The Umpire's Room is located downstairs under the Pavilion and is for use for the umpires only.

Upstairs is the main lounge, Café facilities, meeting rooms, offices, and toilets.

The Technical staff will be utilizing the rear meeting room upstairs in the Pavilion, and the NHA Staff office is located opposite the toilets upstairs in the Pavilion.

Carparking

Car parking is available all around the facility, parking is at your own risk NHA is not liable if your car is damaged while parking near the facilities.

Dugouts

Dugouts are available on both turfs. There is a potable water tap available. Each Team and Officials will have access to their own area, and we discourage any supporters from accessing them over the week.

This will be allocated from the Draw to each Team. Please store your gear on the bench at the dugout until the previous teams have departed and remove all rubbish upon existing.



Turf Rules

- Enter and exit by gates only – please DO NOT climb or sit on the fences.
 - Please DO NOT leave gear on the side lines.
 - NO WARMUPS on the turf while a game is in progress.
 - NO SPECTATORS inside the perimeter fence or dugouts.
- It shall be the responsibility of team managers to ensure all care is taken to stem the flow of blood from injury onto the turf or other players. Injured players must be removed from the playing area until the bleeding has been stopped and covered.
 - NO SMOKING, FOOD or DRINK is permitted inside the perimeter fence.
 - Please DO NOT deliberately or constantly hit balls into the fence boards.
 - NO SMOKING or DOGS allowed inside the external fence.
- Only the maximum, of 11 players from each team and the appointed umpires may be on the field of play during a match. Only the registered substitute players and a maximum of 4 named team management staff are allowed in the dugout of which one can be a physio (minimum). If there is no physio, teams will be limited to 3 named team management staff in the dugout (1 coach, 1 manager, 1 extra).

First Aid

Teams are to bring their own first aid kit. NHA will provide one first aid kit that will be located upstairs in the Pavilion and will provide an alcohol solution in each dugout to clean up any blood on the surface.

HNZ will provide an ambulance and medical staff will be present for all games.

Nelson Hospital is only 12 minutes' drive from the turf and ambulances are on call. Full cellphone coverage is available at the facility.
